



The Post Graduate Course in Systemic Therapy and Family Therapy has training program accreditation from the Australian Association of Family Therapy (AAFT).

### **About the training**

You'll need a previous qualification in the medical or allied health professions and be currently working in a clinical role.

- The foundation level focuses on understanding the concepts and developing skills in Systemic Family Therapy. The second year focuses on narrative and solution focused approaches and the integration of these with systemic therapy.
- There is an emphasis on understanding the clinical implications of developing relational and contextual perspectives to emotional, behavioral and mental health problems.
- Plenty of focused skills development practice, and observation of family therapy sessions.
- Supervised family therapy practice with clients referred to the Low Fee Clinic, with video reviews of sessions to enhance learning.
- Learning how to participate in reflecting teams.
- · Articles are provided and discussed weekly.
- Maps of practice and scales of systemic competencies are used to help with the learning and the application of systemic skills.

## Who is the training for?

This training program is designed for clinicians looking for in depth learning of the theory and practice of Systemic Therapy and Family Therapy. Upon satisfactory completion of the course, trainees are eligible to apply for clinical membership of the AAFT.

This level consists of 200 hours, meeting weekly for 5 hours, on Tuesdays from 12.00pm to 5.00pm beginning Tuesday, 13th February, 2024 at 2/141 Stirling Highway, Nedlands, Perth.
